How to prepare the match slips:

1. Print on standard 8.5"x11" letter paper.
2. Cut each match slip out with scissors or another cutting tool
3. Staple together (or connect by other methods) match slips to create a packet for your judges (this is optional)

How to use match slips:

- Write the current round number that the match is part of and your name as the judge of the match (this is so the slip can be referenced later in case of issues)
- Print each blader's name/username **clearly** on the corresponding side of the match slip that they are to you as the judge (if they are on your left, write their name on the left side)
- Use tally marks to keep track of points for each blader
- Write down Winning Combos when necessary
- Have either the winner of the match, or the judge of the match give the match slips to whoever is running the bracket so it can be recorded
